




## Q4 Which gender do you identify with?



## Q5 Do you consider your gender identity to be different from your registered sex at birth?



















## Q14 What is your religion or belief?




## Q15 What is your sexual orientation?



Q16 What type of school did you mainly attend between the ages of 11 and 16? (If you changed schools, please base your answer on the last 2 years of your education.)








## Q19 Are you a primary carer for a child or children under 18?
